Positives: Great build quality (expected) and ability to swap tubes

Negatives: Would like a little more warmth/bass/breakup, but it's the nature of the amp. Most noticeable lack is when playing thicker textures, like 3 draw/4 draw or 2 draw/5 draw combos, the amp doesn't plume (produce resonant bass). This is very evident live, but not so in the studio.
